

Here's a Suggestion We Might Consider

When we ask what we could do to make Montevallo a better looking town, we might consider the following very frank but friendly letter which has come to the editor of The Times in the past week:

“Mr. Wyatt:

“I want to call your attention to the way the people spit on your sidewalks in front of the Strand Theatre and Klotzman's. You can hardly walk for phlegm and tobacco spit. It is just awful.

“I thought you people might take it up with your Mayor and make it a fine to spit on the sidewalks.

“I visit your town three or four times a week, and I have never seen as much filth on any streets as there is on your sidewalks in any other town.”
